Qualified applicants are invited to apply for an Academic Assistant role in the following course for Fall/Winter 2026 -27. Academic Assistant positions are filled according to the Collective Agreement between Queen's University and [USW Local 2010, Unit 01](#).

Fall/Winter term appointments are for the period Sept 1, 2026 – April 30, 2027.

Remuneration:

The hourly rate of pay for Academic Assistant positions is \$34.25 + 7% in lieu of benefits and vacation.

Hours/Schedule: This contract is for 130 hours from September 1, 2026 – April 30, 2027. Candidates must be prepared to work outside the regular 9–5 work week and have access to the internet and a computer that meets minimum requirements.

Course Name: DRAM 200 Theatre Histories and Traditions Units: 6.00 (Fall/Winter Term)

Course Description: A survey of theatre traditions examining production methods, performance techniques, and dramatic literatures in their cultural contexts from early history to the end of the 19th century.

A Description of Work: The successful candidate will support the instructor by maintaining the class learning management system, meeting with students, providing feedback, grading assignments, and helping monitor and administer class accommodation, as well as other duties as assigned.

Job Requirements: Candidates must have extensive knowledge of spoken and written English to provide feedback on assignments; Significant familiarity with subject matter (global theatre histories prior to the twentieth century); Ability to facilitate online discussions with students; Ability to invigilate in-person quizzes and tests as required; Ability to set-up and maintain an onQ website. A graduate degree in theatre or drama or relevant subject is required.
